- Stronger representation from other NIH Institutes



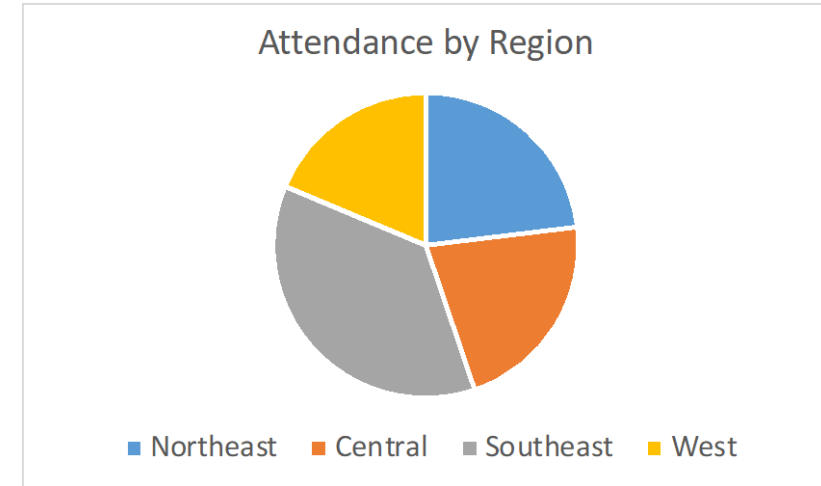
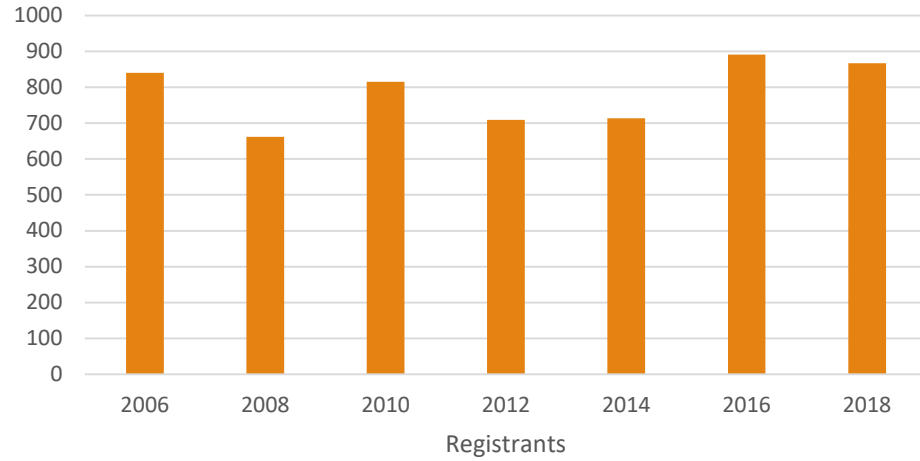
# Conference Statistics

- 9 oral presentation sessions (93 presenters)

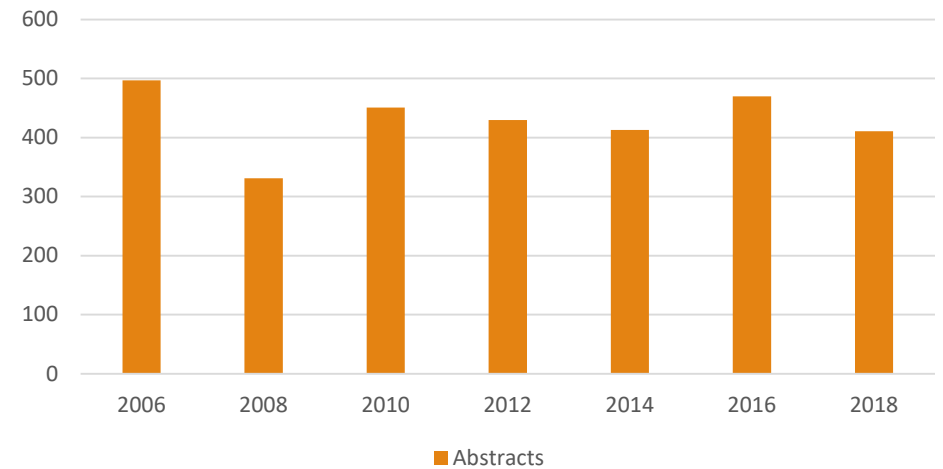

Registrants

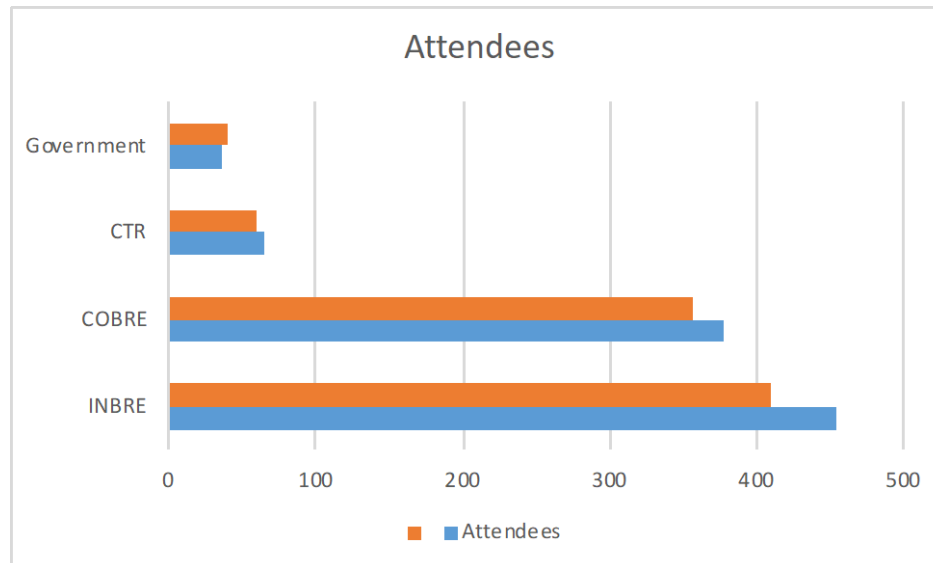
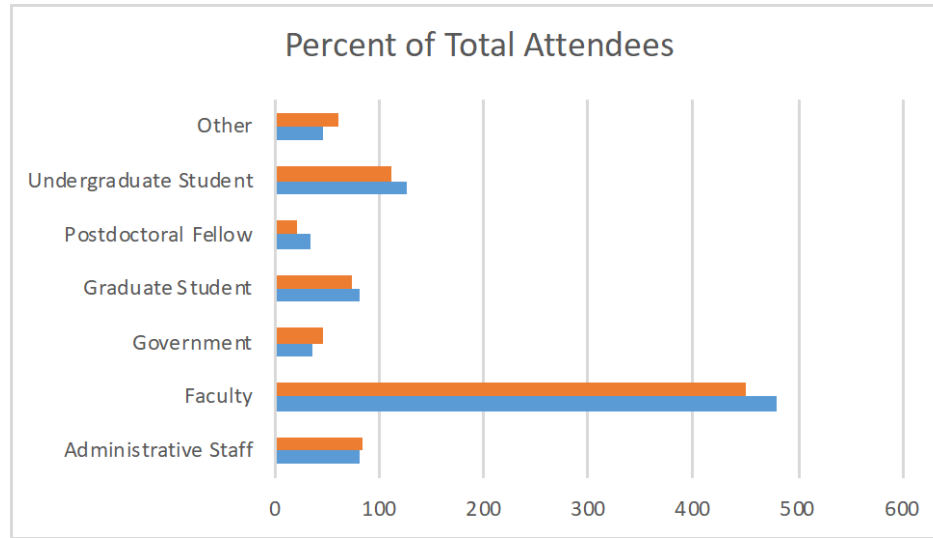

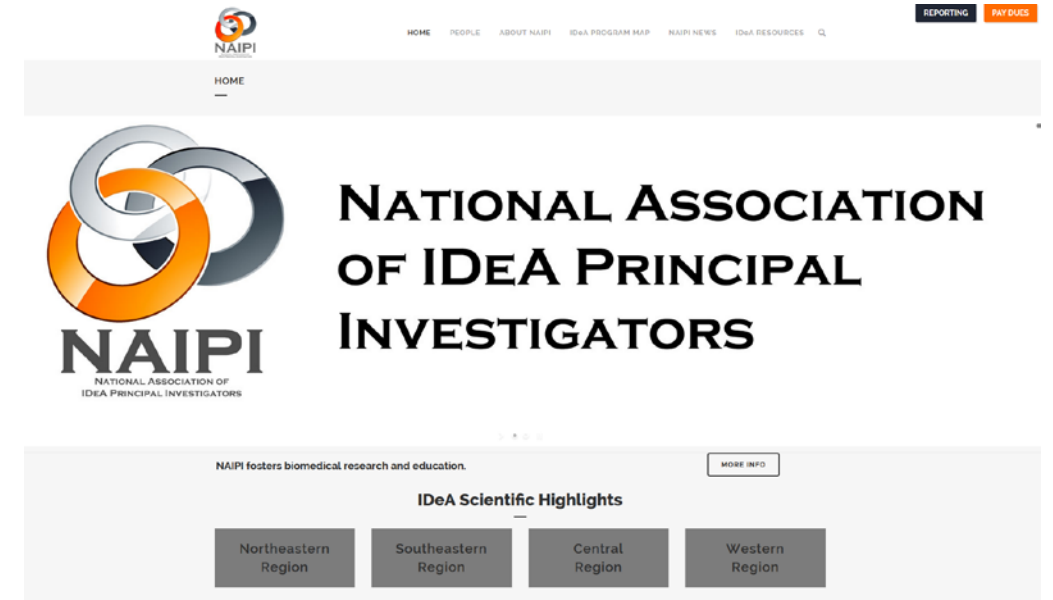
