



Sharon Rounds, MD, is Professor of Medicine and of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine and Associate Dean for Clinical Affairs at the Warren Alpert Medical School of Brown University and staff pulmonary/critical care physician at the Providence VA Medical Center. Dr. Rounds has combined careers in clinical pulmonary/critical care medicine, teaching, and research on the pulmonary circulation. Her research interests include mechanisms of endothelial cell injury and the pathobiology of pulmonary hypertension and ARDS. She has been continuously supported by research grants from the NIH and/or VA since 1981.

Sharon Rounds has served as a regular member of NIH, VA, and various foundation study sections. She was elected President of the American Thoracic Society in 2004-05. In recognition of achievements in clinical care, research, and education in the area of pulmonary/critical care medicine, Dr. Rounds was Edward Livingston Trudeau Medalist of the American Thoracic Society, a Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science, and Breathing for Life awardee of the ATS Foundation.

Sharon Rounds is co-PI (with Elizabeth Harrington) of the CardioPulmonary Vascular Biology Center for Biomedical Research Excellence (CPVB COBRE). This multi-investigator grant builds vascular biology expertise in Rhode Island and is currently in Phase 2 of funding. She is also Pilot Projects Program Lead for the Rhode Island Center for Clinical and Translational Research, "Advance-CTR".
