



Dr. Surendra Sharma is **Professor of Pediatrics and Director of NIH-funded Center of Excellence for Reproductive Health** at Women and Infants Hospital-Warren Alpert Medical School of Brown University, Providence, Rhode Island, USA. In the recent past, he served as President of the American Society of Reproductive Immunology. He has served as the organizer and/or the Scientific Chair of numerous National and International Conferences on Reproductive Biology and Immunology. He has been well - funded from the NIH and other funding sources and has served as a review panel member of the NIH and American Diabetes review panels. His recent work describing an etiological and epidemiological link between preeclampsia and Alzheimer's disease has been widely received. He has successfully established well-defined mouse models for fetal loss, preeclampsia, preterm birth and gestational diabetes. **He currently serves as Editor-in-Chief of the American Journal of Reproductive Immunology.**
