



Paul Sorgen, PhD, serves as PD/PI for the NE-INBRE project. Dr. Sorgen received his BS (Zoology, '93) and PhD (Dr. Cain; Biochemistry and Molecular Biology (**BMB**), '99) from the University of Florida. Upon graduation, Dr. Sorgen became a Research Associate (Dr. Girvin; Dept. of Biochemistry) at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine and was supported by a NIH Postdoctoral Fellowship. In '03, Dr. Sorgen obtained a tenure track faculty position in the Dept. of

BMB at UNMC and is currently a Professor with tenure (since '13). Dr. Sorgen has developed and maintains a nationally funded research program through awards from the NIH (R01s) as well as the AHA and State of Nebraska. In recognition of his scientific accomplishments, Dr. Sorgen has received the Distinguished New Scientist Award (UNMC, '09) and Distinguished Scientist Award (UNMC, '11).
